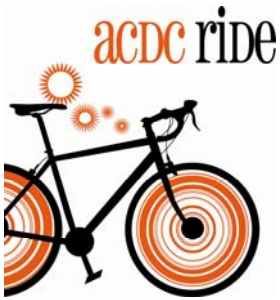


Associated Charities of Lenawee County Presents...

The relevant details:

ROUTES: This year will again offer 7- and 14-mile family-friendly rides along the beautiful Kiwanis Trail bike path. For those looking to pedal a while longer, we are expanding the longer routes to 50K and 100K. All routes will depart from Trestle Park. There will be a hospitality table with refreshments at registration, rest stops along the way in roughly 12-mile increments, and SAG vehicles monitoring the routes.

TIME: Registration will open at 8:00a. Riders doing the 100K route must roll out by 8:30a. Riders on the 50K must depart by 9:30a. Those riding the bike path will depart by 10:30a. Lunch and live music will run from 12p to 2p. The event closes at 2:30p.

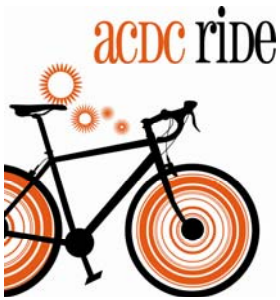
FEE: Registration for riders 16 and above is \$25. Riders under the age of 16 pay \$10 and must be accompanied by an adult. The maximum cost of a family registration is \$60 *if* you pre-register. Participants are urged to pre-register. Everyone who pre-registers will be guaranteed an event t-shirt on the day of the ride and their name will be entered in a drawing to win a door prize.

Private or organizational sponsorships are available, which will get the name of your company or organization on the back of the event t-shirt and on other promotional materials. In-kind sponsorships are also welcome.

Volunteers are also needed. If you're not able to ride, why not offer to help with registration or the hospitality table, one of the water stops, or with some other aspect of the event? It's a fantastic way to be part of the fun and to support a good cause.

We're hoping to see 150 riders at this event. Will you be one of them?

ACDC Bike Ride Release of Liability:

I, the undersigned, know that participating in the AC/DC Bike Ride is a potentially hazardous activity and I participate in it out of my own free will and choice. In choosing to participate in the AC/DC Bike Ride and related events, I fully accept and assume all risks including without limitation, physical injury, mental injury or trauma, death, contact with other participants, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment, the effects of weather including extreme temperature conditions, traffic, contact with motor vehicles of all types and descriptions, collision with other riders or fixed objects, the conditions of the road and participating in events along the route all such risks being known and appreciated by me. I assume the risk of all conditions and potential occurrences during the AC/DC Bike Ride and its related events and waive all specific notice of the existence of either. I shall pay my own medical and emergency expenses in the event of accident, illness, or other incapacity regardless of whether I have authorized such expense. I realize the AC/DC Bike Ride requires physical conditioning and I represent that I am in sound medical condition capable of participating in the ride without risk to myself or others. I have no physical or medical impediment which would endanger me or others. I understand and agree that a situation may arise during the AC/DC Bike Ride which may be beyond the control of the sponsors, promoters or organizers and agree to ride so as not to endanger myself or others. I agree to be solely responsible for the condition and adequacy of my bicycle, safety gear and riding equipment. Having read this waiver and knowing these facts and in consideration of my entry acceptance, I for myself and anyone acting on my behalf, waive and release AC/DC Bike Ride sponsors and participating clubs, communities and organizations; AC/DC Bike Ride officials, volunteers and their representatives; official "Friends of the Associated Charities of Lenawee County and the officers, directors, employees, representatives, agents, and successors of all of the above, from any and all claims of any kind I have, may have or may hereafter accrue against the released parties either directly or indirectly, including claims brought by third parties, arising out of or caused by any act, or failure to act, by the above persons and entities. I further agree to indemnify and hold the parties released above from any and all losses, damages, claims and expenses, including attorneys fees, arising from or relating in any respect to my participation in the SC/Dc Bike Ride or related events. I further agree to abide by all SC/DC Bike Ride rules and regulations. I further understand photo taken of me during this ride may be use in future newsletters or ride brochures.
